Orientation Checklist

- Discuss highlights of Site Access Rules with member and confirm they received and read a copy when they joined the club.
- Discuss highlights of the RCFV Flight Rules with member and confirm they received and read a copy when they joined the club.
- Discuss the Flight Boundaries with member and review the Flight Boundaries map posted at the field
- Discuss Crash Reporting procedures with new member as posted at the field

Pilot Certification – Fixed Wing

- Check flight controls
- Range check plane if not done previously
- Use of throttle cut for electric airplanes when carrying the aircraft to and from the engine cut line on the taxiway.
- Taxi safely onto the runway and under control
- Take off on runway in the correct direction in relation to the wind while maintaining directional control
- Complete 2 circuits of the field under control and within proper boundaries
- Land safely on the asphalt or grass runway for aircraft with wheels. Aircraft without wheels may land on the runway or the grass
- Turn on to the taxiway
- Turn off engine before the cut engine line on the taxiway
- Use of appropriate callouts for intentions – taxiing, taking off, landing, dead stick, on the runway etc. (see Flight Rules for full list of callouts)

Flight Authorization or Training Referral (please select one)

- The member is cleared to fly solo having passed the requirements of the Pilot Certification Test.
- The member should be referred to a flight instructor for additional training.
