Thanks to Isaac Zelazny, Scott Anderson and the Hague family, our club was there to show the Young Eagles some fantastic scale models and tell them all about the R/C hobby while they waited their turn to fly.

The Young Eagles program is part of the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) established in 1992 that brings the flying experience to young folks (teens) by directly inviting them to the cockpits of aircraft owned by its members. There is no cost to the kids at all. It is set up and managed at each EAA chapter in the USA. The aim of the program is to expose the kids to the aviation field in any capacity from pilots to engineers to ground personnel etc...

At this particular event, February 22, the EAA Venice Chapter # 1285 had 10 aircraft and a total of 28 kids flying mostly for the first time. They are given initial briefing and are allowed to control the aircraft in the air with the certified pilot in command.
