Secretary's Report: Meeting Minutes are published in the Scramble Sheet monthly and posted on the Club Website.

Treasurer's Report: Dave Walters reported the following:

Agenda discussion led by President John Dexter:

The Club's Financial audit was held and no financial discrepancies were found.

A motion to proceed with a trial vote was seconded, vote by hand confirmed a majority supported the motion. It was confirmed that all current paid up full membership individuals will have a vote.

President John then reminded the Membership about our planned Family Day on 03/22/2025, Saturday, from 10am to 2pm.

Club Member Isaac Zelazny reviewed the Club participation with the Young Eagles Organization on 2/22/25 at the Venice Airport. The event was very successful as was the Venice Airport Open house held on 03/01/2025 from 9am-3pm. Plenty of RC Aircraft were on display and the interest was very high with many questions.

President John & George LeBlanc spoke about the proposed roofing repair project cost and content. Much discussion on the addition of support cross members, vertical uprights. Also, some discussion about doing and Engineering Study but it was deemed to be too expensive and the our Contractor assured us that with all the revisions & additions the roof structure will be far more robust. A vote was taken to authorize the \$8000 expenditure with an additional 10% allowance for any needed or unforeseen expenses. A vote was taken and approval was near unanimous with only 2 "NO" Votes out of 40.
