April 12th, 2025 - Held at Memorial Field

The monthly meeting opened at 10:00 AM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

27 Members were present including Board Members President John Dexter, Treasurer Dave Walters, VP Lee Shaver, and Directors at Large George LeBlanc, Vaughn Abbot, and Paul Scalisi.

Secretary's Report: Meeting Minutes are published in the Scramble Sheet monthly and posted on the Club Website.

Treasurer's Report: Dave Walters reported the following:

Monthly Receipts: \$2004, \$1400 was donations for roof repairs , Expenses 3684, \$3500 was for roof repair materials, Reduction of \$1631 for the period.

Membership Count: 113 with 105 paying.

New Members: Spouse Sujata Dixit-Joshi and Junior member Grayson Daily.

Agenda discussion led by President John Dexter:

The main topic of discussion today is flying out of bounds. About 3 weeks ago Lindsey saw someone flying way beyond the boundary. The issue is simply misjudging the turning point. The Board has decided to take the following steps:

1. Move all of numbered signs on the North fence, one position to the East. 1. The #1 will be larger and brighter in some way.
2. Encourage everyone to have a spotter, particularly those flying larger planes.
3. Ask the Landfill if we can put a flag at the new #1 position.
4. Structure a response to repeat offenders.
5. Give further consideration to moving a flight cage East.
