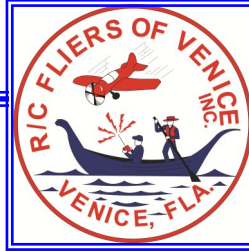

### Elections

### Flight rules revisions concerning West Boundary Fly Zone over flights

Safety Officer Sanjeev Joshi explained the email he sent to all members on November 8<sup>th</sup> 2025. It covered the closing of Flight Station #1, recommended having a spotter, noted the location of #1 and #2 signs along the North fence as indications for when to start the crosswind turn and the procedure to follow if a pilot needs to retrieve an aircraft from the runway. A discussion followed with numerous number questions. John Dexter pointed

out the large Flight Rules sign posted on the building and suggested members read and follow them. Past president Jim Hullhorst stated that we are not a private club and we need to follow AMA rules as well as County Landfill restrictions. It is as simple as that.

### Bylaws revisions status

John noted that bylaws revisions are under way, asked for input and stated that a draft will be sent to members when we are completely happy with them. That will not be for a while.

### WOV this year

We would like to have our Wings Over Venice next year around the end of March. We'll need at least 30 members to step forward and volunteer. Let John Kinney know if you can help.

### New Projects

About this time of year, we put together a list of projects for the ensuing year. John Dexter asked John Kinney to step forward and comment. He enthusiastically said that we have a request for estimates to install a 100 foot high golf driving net along our West Boundary! Kidding. We want to make this place look really nice. The product Morrell, a concrete type mixture with gravel, could be put down along the fence rows, flight boxes and parking areas as a permanent weed barrier. Another thing is to remove the parking area polls to make mowing easier. Poles could be repurposed into portable poles for events such as WOV. Another thing is to rearrange the signs along the safety fence, so they are not hanging on the wires. We also need to pressure wash all the white fences. **John then proposed a workday to get more members involved. Let's be proud of our club! And lets have Wings Over Venice again!!** Any more ideas?
